**CUR, FAL, SPR, SMR**

There are system parameters that determine what term we are associating with each of these tags.

CUR = Current Term It starts after End of Term (EOT) for the prior term

FAL = Fall Term

SPR = Spring Term

SMR = Summer Term Note: Since Summer Term starts so close to the end of the Spring Term. The “CUR” term will not switch to the Summer Term until after the Summer Term has begun.

**CEN\_CUR and CEN\_HIS**

Census is

- For Fall and Spring, the census date is 12 school days from the start of the term. It ends up being the Wednesday of the third week because we have MLK, Jr and Labor Day holidays between start of term and census.
- Summer is the 8<sup>th</sup> day of the 8 week subterm starting the 5<sup>th</sup> week. And that is also a Wednesday. Generally it is late June.

We capture these files on the following Friday evening after the regular ODS refreshes.
